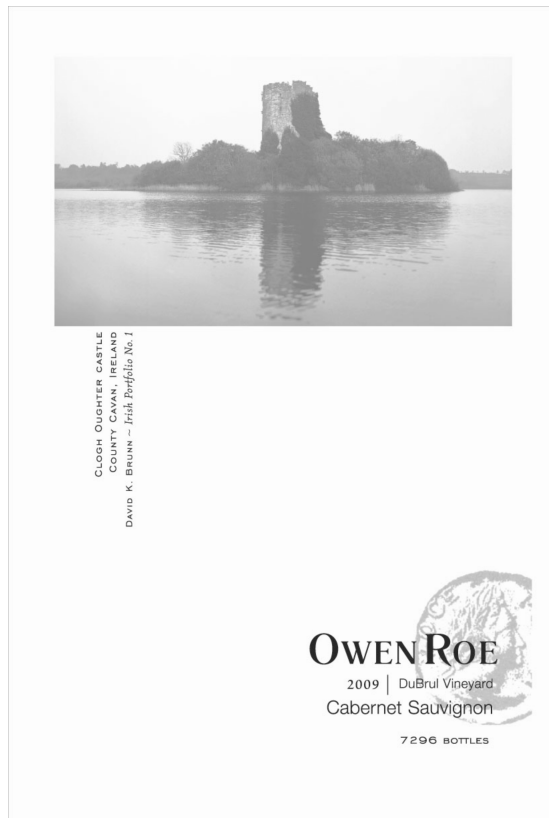


2009 CABERNET SAUVIGNON DuBrul Vineyard

VINEYARD NOTES

Hugh and Kathy Shiels planted DuBrul Vineyard and meticulously maintain their hilltop vines in the Yakima Valley of Washington. The depth of flavor and concentration are unlike any that we have come across in the West Coast due to the growing area, severity of pruning, and miniscule yields. The fruit was picked in mid-October when taste alone determined it was ripe. Once in the winery, only minimal and traditional handling practices were employed.



TASTING NOTES

The 2009 is powerful and masculine with flavors of rich black fruits, deftly interwoven with notes of wild violet and mocha. Luscious blackcurrant is mingled with flavors of purple sage and savory herbs, all of which come together on a beautifully structured, long finish. This wine will age beautifully.
